On behalf of the organizing committee, it is our great pleasure to announce that the 1<sup>st</sup> Osong Symposium on Infectious Diseases [OSID 2011] will be held from November 1 to 3, 2011 at Osong, Korea.

Korea National Institute of Health (KNIH) has been collaborated with National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Disease, US NIH in the various research areas of infectious diseases such as vaccine development and pandemic influenza research for many years.
